to the use and finding of my daughter and for their marriage till such some of money as here
under I have appointed theym be fully leaved and provided of the said land tenement and rent and other
the pmisses and afterwards to remain to my son Roger and to the heires male of his body lawfully be-
gotten and for lacke of such yssue male of the said Roger the said rent of the said land to remain to the right
heires of the said Roger lewkenor knyght my father according to the tenor of his last will. It I will that
my agents of offynnyng and warrante in the said county of Suffolke and all other my lands and tenement the said county
of Suffolke before the Comite of the said county of Suffolke shall receive and take the yssues and profits of the same for the
of the said county after my decease to the use behoof and profit of the said daughter and finding of the said Roger
my son James Clemente daughter and Elizabeth my daughter till they and any of theym shall come to the age of
twenty years. The surplusage if any be to be employed to the use of my said daughter and if any of
theym should die she or they should die to have the hole and all the said profits be employed my said profits
to make to the said Roger my son a state of and in the said land and tenement and other the pmisses to the
entire value of the said land and tenement and to the heires male of his body lawfully begotten and for lacke of
such yssue the remainder thereof to Edmund my son and to the heires male of his body lawfully begotten and for
lacke of such yssue to the right heires of the said Roger lewkenor knyght my father. The residue to remain still in my
said profits hand to the use and behoof of the marriage of my said daughter that is to say to any of theym or to
to be provided and taken of the profits of the said land and tenement. And if any of my said daughter should
decease before the marriage she or they that only she to have the hole some of money and wherof the said some
of money be leaved of the pmisses then I will that my said profits shall make a state of the said land and tenement to
my said son Roger and to the heires male of his body lawfully begotten and for lacke of such yssue of the said
Roger to my said son Edmund and to the heires male of his body begotten and for lacke of such yssue male
of the body of the said Edmund to the right heires of the said Roger lewkenor my father for ever according to the
last will of my said father. It I will that the rent yssues and profits of all my messuages land and tenement
of feohold in the county of Suffolke be employed for an obit during the space of twenty years next after
my decease for my soule and my wife and our fathers and mothers and all our children as in & by here to annexed
more plainly appears to be kept yearly during the said time in the paroch of Boreham and after the said twenty
years expired the said land and tenement to remain to my son Edmund and to the heires male of his
body lawfully begotten and for lacke of such yssue to remain to Roger my son and to the heires male
of his body lawfully begotten and for lacke of such yssue the said land and tenement to be sold by my said
agents and profits and the money thereof to be employed in deed of charity for the welfare off
my soule and all my friends soules. It I will that Thomas Maister of putney in the County of Suffolke
shall peacefully enjoy all the said land and tenement in the County of Suffolke the said county of Suffolke I
late sold hym and if the said Thomas his heires or assigns be doted expelled or putt out of the said
land and tenement in the County of Suffolke above said by due proces of the lawe or otherwise lawfully putt out by Roger my
son or by any other of my heires that they the said Thomas his heires and assigns immediately after such
putt by the due proces of the lawe shall have and enjoy to theym and to their heires all my land and tenement
in the County of Suffolke called lodeys land hadenbruff land Shorter and Mablethryng whiche I late purchased and all my land
and tenement in the County of Suffolke called Jales whiche I late purchased all according to the content of certeyn charters
in certeyn indentures made betwene me and the said Thomas Maister. It I will also that if my said son
Roger and Edmund dye without heires male of their bodies lawfully begotten they all my said purchased land
and tenement to remain to my right heires for ever. It I will that Edmund my son have my ferme of Tang-
mere during such years as I have the same by the licence & favour of my suster good lord my lord of
Cambridg and certeyn other of Englonde wherof I humbly beseeche to be good lord unto my suster
son Edmund.
