John Silvester the sum of ten pounds to be paid to him by my Executor out of my one hundred pounds which I have reserved out of the said ten pounds and as to all the remainder of my Estate both real and personal of what nature kind or quality soever after payment of my debts charges and funeral Charges and probate of this my will I do hereby give and bequeath unto my aforesaid friend and pidgeon Madford in trust for my aforesaid daughter Elizabeth Silvester and I do hereby nominate and appoint the said pidgeon Madford the Executor of this my will in trust for my said daughter Elizabeth until she shall attain the age of one and twenty years and then I do hereby constitute my said daughter full and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and my will and mind is that my Executor pidgeon Madford shall be put unto any charges or expenses in relation to the trust hereby expressed in him that he shall in the first place reimburse himself of my doctory annuity or any other part of my Estate that shall come to his hands to whome for his trouble and care herein I give one Cornishian shilling and I do hereby revoke all former wills by me at any time heretofore made and do ordaine and ratify this and none other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and twenty Demarad Silvester signed sealed published and declared by the said Demarad Silvester the testatrix as and for her last will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence subscribed our names as witnesses thereto Mary Gade the mark of Susannah Roman.

The sixth day of April in the year of our Lord God 1721 and in the seventh year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Brittain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith etc Anthony Stopp of Stone in the County of Durke being sick and weak in body but of good and perfect memory thanks be to God do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first I bequeath my soul and spirit into the hands of Almighty God my heavenly Father by whose mercy and only Grace I trust to be saved and revived into Eternall rest through the death of my saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ in whose precious blood I set my whole and only hope of my salvation my distressed body in hopes of a joyfull resurrection I commit to the Earth to be buried with such charges and in such place as my Executors shall think good And touching the distribution of my mortall goods I dispose of the same as followeth first I give and bequeath to my wife Martha my household goods during her life and after her decease to my children to be equally divided betwixt and my daughter Cathrine and daughter Martha

and the Child that my Wife is now bigg of and all the rest of my goods and Chattels to be equally divided amongst my Wife and Children and my Children to have it when they come to the age of twenty years and the interest of it to breed them up till they come to the age of twenty years and then the principall part in case either of my Children should die before they come to the age of twenty years either of their part or moiety shall fall to the survivors and provided my Children all should die then my Wife shall have the sum of One hundred over and above her share aforesaid likewise I give and bequeath to my Brother W^m Stopp the sum of thirty pounds and what more is left to be equally divided amongst my Brother and Sisters Children in the space of twelve months after the decease of my said Children desiring all my just and true debts to be paid I leave also Martha my Wife to be my full whole and only Executrix of this my last Will and Testament I also ordain my Brother Robert Stopp and Isaac Stopp and William Adunt Executors for my Wife and Children requiring them to see this my last Will and Testament performed accordingly and I do utterly revoke all former Wills and Testaments by me in any wise heretofore made or declared in writing whosoever I have heretofore set my hand the day and year first above written
