I James Stepes belonging to her Majesty's Ship Suffolk being in
 bodily health and of sound and disposing minde and memory And
 considering the perills and dangers of the sea and other uncertainties
 of this transitory life doe for avoiding controversies after my
 decease make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament
 in manner following (that is to say) first I Recommend my Soul to
 God that gave it And my Body I commit to the Earth or Sea as
 it shall please God to order and as for and concerning all my
 worldly Estate I give bequeath and dispose thereof as followeth
 (that is to say) unto my honoured Mother Bartolomew Stepes in his
 County of Cripplegate in the County of Middlesex All such
 Wages. Oune and Summes of money Lends Tenements Goods Chattells
 and Estate whatsoever as shall be any waies due or belonging
 unto me at the time of my decease I doe give devise and bequeath
 the same unto the said Bartolomew Stepes And I doe hereby
 nominate and appointe the said Bartolomew Stepes my Exe-
 cutour of this my last Will and Testament And by revoking all former
 and other Wills Testaments and Deeds of Gift by me at any
 time heretofore made And I doe ordain and ratifie these
 presents to stand and be for and as my only last Will and
 Testament In Witnes whereof to this my said Will I have set my
 hand and seale the sixteenth Day of February Anno Domini
 1707 And the third year of the Reigne of her Majesty Queen
 Ann over England J. Stepes Signed sealed and published
 in the presence of us Richard Green Gunner Allan Miller
 Boatwaine Gill. Montuif Clerk.
