 think it proper to make my Will and accordingly I do make
 this my last Will and Testament in manner following first
 of all I recommend my Soul to Almighty God hoping through
 the satisfaction of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to be saved
 according to my Will is that all my Debts shall be fully paid
 and discharged them I give and bequeath to my dear Wife Mary
 Stopp five hundred Pounds and also that Estate of mine which
 I have in the Shelswell Parishes so long as my dear Wife Mary Stopp
 do live and after her decease to my Brother Jark Stopp and my
 Brother William Stopp to be equally divided between them two
 them I give and bequeath to my Brother John Stopp three Children
 twenty Pounds apiece when they come to the Age of twenty one
 years old and in case either of them dies before they come to
 that Age then it is to be divided between the other Children of
 John Stopp them I give and bequeath to my Brother Jark Stopp
 four Children twenty Pounds apiece when they come to the Age
 of twenty one years old and in case either of them dies before
 they come to Age then it is to be divided between the other
 Children of Jark Stopp them I give and bequeath to my Brother
 William Stopp ten forty Pounds when he comes to the Age of
 twenty one years old them I give and bequeath to my Brother
 Anthony Stopp three Children twenty Pounds apiece when they
 come to the Age of twenty one years old and in case either of
 them dies before they come to Age then it is to be divided between
 the other Children of Anthony Stopp them I give and bequeath to
 my Sister Wealth in Godneys four Children twenty Pounds apiece
 when they come to the Age of twenty one years old and in case
 either of them dies before they come to Age then it is to be
 divided between the other Children of Wealth in Godneys them I
 give and bequeath to my Widow Mary Finch twenty Pounds
 when she comes to the Age of twenty one years old them I
 give and bequeath to my Man Thomas Turvey twenty Pounds to

be payd to him at seven years or sooner if his said Jane Stopp
 thinks fitt and as to the Estate of Widdowes which lies in Stratford
 Lordship & give and bequeath to my Brother John Stopp after all
 the Legacies which is above mentioned are fully payd and my Wife
 is that my Sister Martha Stopp shall live in my house at Stratford
 aforesaid so long as she pleased keeping it in good repair without
 paying Rent for it and to have a Cow sleeping in the Grounds at a
 reasonable Rate both Winter and Summer provided she do not hold
 the Grounds herself and I do appoint the Rent of that Estate to be
 payd to my dear Wife Mary Stopp till all the Legacies are fully payd
 Item I constitute and appoint by this my last Will my dear Wife
 Mary Stopp to be my sole Executrix of all my Goods and Chattels
 and it is my Will that Thomas Wiltshire and John Wistar be
 Executors in Trust to see that my Will be fulfilled and my body to
 be decently buryed and it is my Will that Thomas Wiltshire and
 John Wistar shall have a Guinea apiece to buy them a Mourning
 Ring apiece & having this my last Will published in the year of
 our Lord 1724. Robert Stopp his Marke. Signed Published and
 declared by the above named Robert Stopp to be his last Will and
 Testament the Day and Year above named Robert Upston Mary Perkins
 Thomas Wiltshire his Marke

 and a Trustee of and Guardian to my said Daughter In witness
 whereof I have published and declared this to be my last Will
